North Point Academy students may be "A-G" eligible. Courses meeting an A-G area are noted within course descriptions. Any student hoping to attend a 4 year university directly after high school completion should be completing the A-G requirements.

Academic Enrichment with Sierra Community College

NPA students may want to take a community college course to fulfill university entrance requirements. To be considered for academic enrichment, an appointment with the NPA counselor is required. Any college credit earned may be used toward the 220 graduation credit requirements. This credit is calculated as College units X 3.33. Upon receiving an official transcript, college courses will be added to the student's high school transcript.
